HEALTH & SAFETY

All exhibitors should comply with the requirements set out in the Health and Safety Policy, organisation and arrangements of the Poynton Horticultural & Agricultural Society. Copies of this policy may be obtained from the Society Secretary and will be displayed in the Show Office prior to and during the Show.

Specifically, all exhibitors, trade stand occupiers and entertainment & catering providers are required to maintain their exhibits/areas in such a manner so as to comply with current Health and Safety Regulations and guidance, and to ensure that their activities do not endanger themselves, other exhibitors or members of the general public.

Further specific advice and guidance is available via the Show's Honorary Health and Safety Officer, who may be contacted via the Show Office.

EQUINE INFLUENZA

All horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 – 92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 – 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose. Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the Show.

Foals: In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course. We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times. Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessments by the attending veterinarians.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE EVENT. HOWEVER, RANDOM CHECKS MAY BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS (GDPR)

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) became a legal requirement on 25 May 2018. The 6 main data protection principles by which personal data must be processed are:- a) Processed lawfully, fairly & transparently; b) Collected only for specific & legitimate purposes; c) Should be adequate, relevant & limited to what is needed; d) Must be accurate & kept up to date; e) Stored only as long as is necessary; and f) Ensure appropriate security, integrity & confidentiality. Poynton Horticultural & Agricultural Society and Mobberley Shire Horse Society are committed to protecting your data. Any personal data that you provide to us, or that we may receive from others about you, will be processed in accordance with these principles. Data may be held electronically or in paper format. Both Societies will only use your data and share your data when it has a legitimate reason to do so. During Poynton Show you may be photographed and images may be used at a later date for promotional purposes. You may request removal of your data.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Society's Veterinary Surgeons are on call throughout the show but will be available on the Showground from 8.00am until 7.00pm.

- 1 ALL ANIMALS (except in the classes for Turnouts and Geldings) must be registered or eligible for registration in the SHS Stud Book (Geldings in the Gelding Classes should be by a registered Shire Stallion). Any Horse entered into the Ridden Heavy Horse class must be registered in the main British Stud Books of either the Shire, Clydesdale, Suffolk or British Percheron Society. Any Horse entered into the Inhand Heavy Horse class must be registered in the main British Stud Books of either the Clydesdale, Suffolk or British Percheron Society.
- 2 ALL ANIMALS shall be the property of the Exhibitor who must be a paid-up member of the Shire Horse Society (except Turnout Classes). All Horses entered into the Ridden Heavy Horse/inhand Heavy Horse classes must be entered in the name and ownership they are registered in.
- 3 ALL ENTRIES are subject to the General Conditions of Entry of Poynton Horticultural & Agricultural Society and the Special Conditions applicable to the various Classes in the Schedule.
- 4 Cattle Wagons and Horse Boxes must be parked in the Special Area provided and as directed by the appointed Stewards. (Also see inside front cover).
- 5 All Trophies, which are the property of the respective Societies, must be returned not less than 28 days before the date of the Show. Acceptance of the Custody of any trophy by the holder for the time being shall be a sufficient guarantee that the holder is responsible.
- 6 Grand Parade. Prize winners will be required to parade in the Main Ring at the stated time.
- 7 Prize money will be paid out on the day in the Shire Horse Ring.

20 RIDDEN HEAVY HORSE – To be judged in the Main Ring

Open to Purebred Heavy Horses 4 years old, to be judged on performance and obedience as a riding horse, taking into account the unique nature, conformation and character of the Heavy Horse. Have good manners whilst in the ring, be obedient and responsive of the aids, have correct and active paces, bend and correct canter leads. Entries should be well turned out, tack should be well fitting and suitable for the purpose. If plaited no mane flights are permitted, martingales and other artificial aids (other than whips and spurs) are also not permitted. Hard hats conforming to current safety standard must be worn.

Qualifier for the British Show Horse Association (BSHA) Amateur Home Produced Championship. Final to be held at the BSHA National Championships at Arena UK on 10 September 2022. See BSHA rules below for definition of Amateur/Home Produced. Qualification to be awarded once eligibility has been confirmed by Brist Ridden Heavy Horse Society.

BSHA Definition for Amateur Home Produced Championship Qualifier

A) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

- (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a main source of income.
- (ii) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
- (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, BSHA or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, BSHA or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.

The above Rule does not apply (iv) if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership.

On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.

(B) Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

(C) Amateur Home Produced: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
