





Greater Manchester - Blood Bikes

Blood Bikes Manchester is a registered charity which has just delivered its 17,000th item on behalf of the NHS, North West Air Ambulance and the people of Manchester.

We offer an out of hours, free of charge urgent medical courier service to the NHS. We volunteer to play our part in saving lives and to save the NHS money that would otherwise be used on expensive taxis or couriers.

Our service is provided by volunteers all of which provide their time for no pay or reward, our running costs are kept low however we depend entirely on public sponsorship and donations to maintain a service.

We aim to save our local NHS trusts as much as we possibly can to enable the savings to be put back in to their services where it is needed most. We operate from 7:00pm through to 6:00am during the week and 24 hours at weekends and bank holidays (Inc. all other public holidays) and we choose to use specially adapted motorcycles to give us the maximum flexibility and the best response time; however there are times when it would be unsafe to operate a motorcycle e.g. in thick fog, during snow storms, or other extremes of weather.



Our riders are a hardy bunch that operate in all but the very worst weather, so as a backup we also have fleet cars that can take the place of the motorcycles when needed. Fundraising is extremely important for us, as a charity we do not receive any form of payment for our service, so rely fully on donations from kind members of the public and sponsorships from local businesses.

We are often asked why we do not charge the NHS, even to cover running costs, the simple reason is because we believe we can support the NHS to help save lives, we ask the money we save them is redirected to purchase vital equipment or pay towards staffing. Since the charity formed in 2012, Blood Bikes Manchester has been a member of The Nationwide Association of Blood Bikes.





Just Ice

Ice cream is always joyful and the new ethical ice cream café in Poynton, Just-Ice, is certainly a joyful place. Frequently filled with family groups, grandparents and grandchildren and a whole cross-section of the community, it's a popular hub for spending quality time and indulging in the huge array of ice creams and homemade cakes and bakes.

But this unique café is bringing joy in less obvious ways. It was established as a charity back in 2021 with a vision to help survivors of modern slavery. The café is all about 'Profit for Purpose' and making a difference to those people who have escaped modern slavery.



Modern slavery is the act of obtaining or holding an individual in compelled service. In the UK alone it is estimated that approximately 136,000 people are currently enslaved, the majority of whom are UK nationals. Slavery can take many forms, including: forced labour, human trafficking, forced marriage and debt/bonded labour. Many individuals become trapped in a form of slavery through the exploitation of their poverty or social exclusion by groups wishing to take advantage of individuals experiencing these difficulties Just-lee works to support those who have been freed from slavery. Even when they are physically free many find it difficult to reintegrate into society, particularly when looking for employment or welcoming communities. Equally many are still dealing with significant trauma and struggle with their mental and emotional wellbeing, experiencing anxiety, loneliness, stress and depression. The café provides survivors with work and the opportunity to develop their skills whilst providing practical and emotional support that can help them move forward from the trauma they have suffered. The café has supported four survivors since they opened the doors in October 2021 and has plans to support even more in the next year.

As a social enterprise there are so many ways people can support the amazing work they do. They are always looking for regular donors who would are happy to support the survivors with their travel costs and training but you can also support them by hosting parties at their Park Lane Café or by hiring their ice cream trike. The easiest way is of course to eat their ice cream!


